Austin has a few food trucks everyone already knows. This isn't about those. It's about the trailers tucked behind breweries, parked at gas stations, and hiding in food-park back corners that quietly out-cook the institutions — the ones locals guard a little jealously.

Every entry below cleared a deliberately high bar, then earned its spot with consistency, character, and at least one thing worth crossing town for. Tap any name in the contents to jump straight to it.

The bar for inclusion: a Google rating of **4.8★ or higher** and **100 or more reviews**, limited to genuine food trucks & trailers (no brick-and-mortar restaurants), across the greater Austin metro. Ratings, review counts and hours shift constantly — treat them as a strong signal, not gospel, and call ahead for the trucks with limited days.

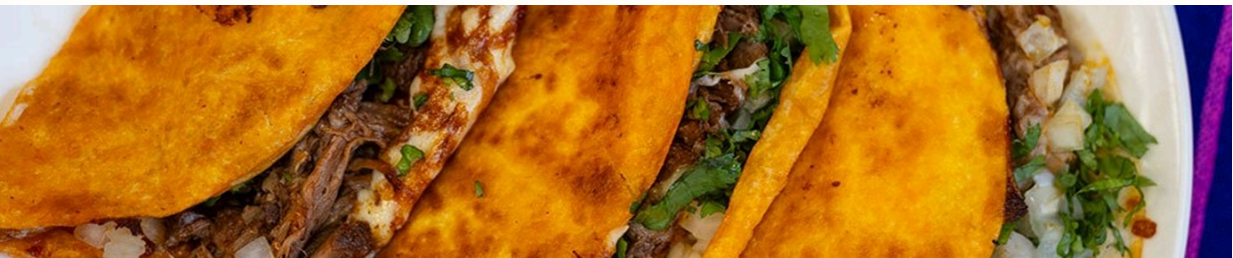

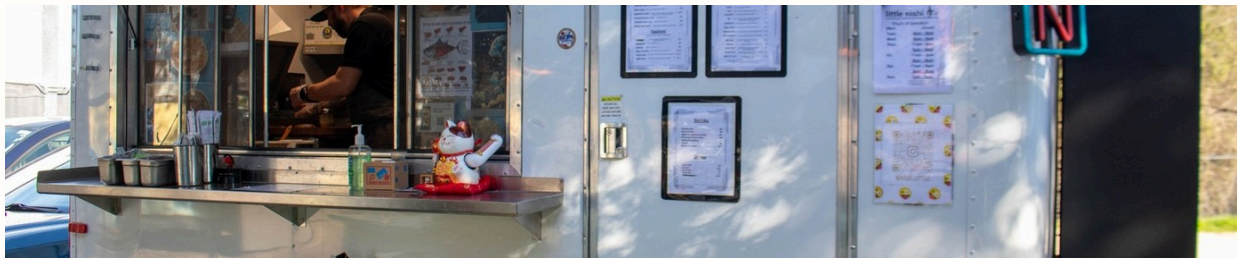

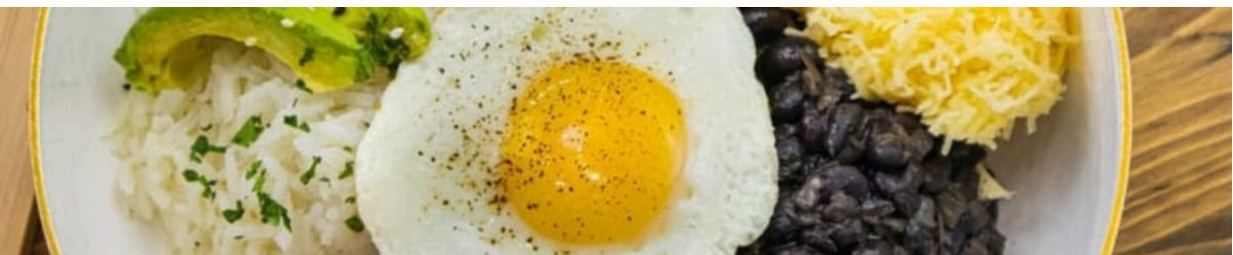

A few honest footnotes

On the photos. The image frames throughout are intentionally left open.
